### What does Europe's homelessness look like?

The Finnish Cultural Institute for the Benelux invites visual artists and community artists to propose new artistic projects dealing with the issue of homelessness. The open call is part of the Mobile Home 2017\* initiative, which explores notions of home.

The successful proposal will receive a production bursary of up to €10 000. Two runner-up proposals will be awarded with a €1000 bursary by ArtHelsinki.

\*Mobile Home 2017 is initiated by the Finnish Cultural and Academic Institutes in Paris, Berlin, Brussels and London.
